### Financial Literacy

- **Arbitrage:** The simultaneous buying and selling of securities in different market to take advantage of difference in prices of same securities
- **Tracking Stock:** Specialized equity offering issued by a company that is based on the operation of specific business unit rather than operation of company as a whole.
- **Securitization:** The process through which an issuer creates a financial instrument by combining other financial assets and then marketing different tiers of the repackaged instruments to investors. This promotes liquidity in the marketplace.
- **Derivatives:** An arrangement of products (such as future, option or warrant) whose value derived from and is independent on the value of an underlying assets such as a commodity and currency.
